RadTech President's Award
Robin Wright of 3M & Dick Stowe of Fusion
Awarded for Achievement

Chevy Chase, MD— Robin Wright of 3M and Dick Stowe of Fusion UV received the 4th annual RadTech President's Award at the RadTech Winter meeting in Ft Lauderdale, FL. This award is presented to individual members that make significant contributions to RadTech and the development of UV and EB technology.

Both Dick and Robin have taken the lead in developing RadTech's UV Measurement Task Force, formed in January 2000. Among the group's goals are to provide technical and educational information to users, researchers and manufacturers concerning the technology and terminology of UV measurement; and to develop and promote sound industry practices and standards of UV measurement. The group created a glossary of terms for UV curing design and measurement—which has been widely adopted and reprinted in several trade journals. Robin and Dick are also spearheading the development of a UV measurement educational CD; and the creation of a UV measurement "TechCell" at the upcoming e|5 biennial UV and EB trade show and conference, May 2-5 in Charlotte. Copies of the CD will be available at the event.

UV and EB are high value, rapid throughput processes offering the virtual elimination of emissions and lower energy consumption compared with traditional methods—providing manufacturers with a safe, fast and efficient pollution prevention technology. As a result, the industry continues to grow at over twice the rate of traditional processes.
